Students enjoyed fun games for fall and Halloween. These games worked on skills like sliding, rolling, throwing (stepping in opposition), and Frisbee throw (stepping with the same foot as throwing hand). Students also participated in some tag games and relays.



Students played “The Frightful Frisbee Throw” game, trying to knock Halloween items off of cones with a Frisbee.



An old favorite is a game from the rhyme “Chickamy, Chickamy, Cranny Crow.” Some students tried to tag others with a throw from a foam Frisbee.

“Grab the pumpkin from the pumpkin patch” challenged students to run and reach the pumpkin before an opponent. We also worked on understand sliding by ghost bowling.
