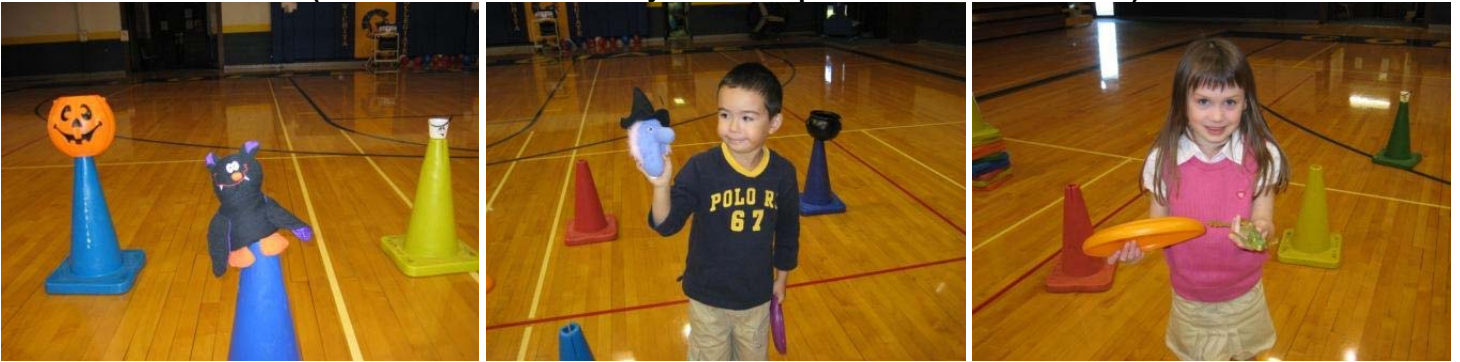
Pumpkin Volleyball
